ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

The annual meeting of the Fredericksburg Sister City Association was held on November 13, 2014 at the Central Rappahannock Library.

President Bill Beck opened the meeting with welcoming remarks.

The Treasurer gave his report describing the major incomes and expenditures in 2014. The highlight this year was our very successful funding raising event held on June 20, 2014 which honored the 70th anniversary of the D-Day landing. Chairing the event was Kathryn Willis, our funding raising chairman. The Treasurer reminded the members to pay their dues for the upcoming year. He also announced that the position of Treasurer will become vacant starting January 2016. He is hoping a member would like to volunteer for this position

Following the Treasurer's report the President reviewed our 2014 year. The organization held the following events in 2014, a Mardi Gras party and the D-Day remembrance of 70th anniversary. Our friends in Fréjus held a ceremony on September 11 remembering the Americans who helped liberate Fréjus. In May Bill made a presentation to the Elder Study

group. July saw the arrival of 20 French exchange students and the Bastille Day picnic. In November the French Congrès was held at a local high school. On Thanksgiving Day the French jumelage held a Thanksgiving dinner in Fréjus.
